Description of the programme

The field of study is designed as a follow-up structured double subject Master's degree, which is combined with elective disciplines at the Faculty of Education, Faculty of Arts and Faculty of Science. The field of study is primarily designed for applicants – graduates from the Bachelor's degree in Music Culture in Education. It focuses on learning music theory, music-educational and music-psychological competences for teaching general and specialized music.

Graduate profile and job opportunities

The graduates will be able to perform educational activities at elementary and secondary schools and music and art schools in all aspects of music teaching (vocal, listening, instrumental, movement, theory and elemental composition). The graduates will also be able to create their teaching materials according to the Framework educational programme for elementary, secondary and art and music schools, and continue to improve own professional qualification.

Admission requirements

The course is designed for Bachelor's degree graduates from Music culture in education under the study programme Specialization in education. Bachelor's degree graduates from similar fields under other study programmes are required, during the admission proceedings, to present a certificate of completion of educational propaedeutics under lifelong learning.

The applicant must prove his/her fitness for study in a motivation letter (in English) and a profile essay $15\,000 - 20\,000$ symbols long, focused on the area of the study program.

Language competence:

- The standard English language requirement is level B2 in accordance to the Common European Framework of Reference for languages (CEFR).
- Minimum language requirements in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): Internet based Test (IbT): 61, Computer based Test (CbT): 173, Paper based Test (PbT): 500 or an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) overall band score of at least 6.0.

The applicants are required to send:

- application (online application form);
- <u>proof of recognition</u> of their previous education (i.e. foreign certificate as equivalent to a certificate of education issued in the Czech Republic);
- motivation letter;
- profile essay;
- CV;
- certificate of language competence

Admission exams

Practical exam – playing a musical instrument, and an interview to verify basic knowledge in the extent of Bachelor's degree in Musical culture in education.
